Warfel Construction Company to build new Nature Center

East Petersburg, PA, December 14, 2010 – Warfel Construction Company was recently awarded a \$700,000 contract to build a new 6,300 sq. ft. Nature Center at Black Rock Retreat in Quarryville, PA.

Being built to expand the center's educational opportunities for year round use, the new center will house two classrooms specifically for nature study and a large display area showcasing preserved specimens and some live animals. Incorporating natural materials such as stone and logs, the new two story building will feature a 10 foot wide deck and will provide natural lighting from the wall to ceiling windows throughout the structure. The facility will be open to the public and provide educational sessions for public, private, and homeschool groups. The project is designed by Tippetts Weaver Architects of Lancaster. Sitework will be managed by BR Kreider Inc. of Manheim. Work is expected to commence in January with completion scheduled for May 2011.
