**SUBJECT: Warfel Construction Company awarded \$5.9 million school contract**

**East Petersburg, PA, October 29, 2009** – Warfel Construction Company recently broke ground for the expansion and renovation of the Weigelstown Elementary School in the Dover Area School District.
