

COVID-19 Mitigation Efforts

As part of our ongoing commitment to ensure a safe working environment for our employees, trade partners, and Clients, we are continuing to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic closely, utilizing guidance from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC). Below, we've listed some of the steps we have taken to ensure business continuity, as well as the safety and health of our team members:



Daily Evaluation and Communication

Workers are screened daily for contact with those with confirmed COVID-19 cases or travel outside the country, and to identify those experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. Our response team meets daily through a remote platform to evaluate the evolving situation, maintain business continuity, and ensure that we are executing our Clients for Life mission. The team communicates any updates and reminders to all Warfel employees on a daily basis.



Reaffirm CDC Hygiene Guidance

Through daily emails, social media posts, and signage, we are encouraging our staff to follow recommended CDC hygiene guidance, including hand washing with soap and water, using hand sanitizer, covering sneezes/coughs with an elbow or tissue, avoiding touching one's face, and cleaning frequently-touched surfaces.



Mandatory Quarantine Enforcement

Employees and trade partners who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 are immediately released from their work area and sent home for testing/quarantine at the discretion of a qualified medical professional. Individuals who have recently returned from traveling abroad or whose family member exhibits COVID-19 symptoms are also required to self-quarantine for a minimum of 14 days.



Social Distancing Policy

Wherever possible, Warfel employees are requested to work from home. Where it is not possible, employees and trade partners must remain a minimum of 6' from each other. Maximum numbers have been established for job trailers and conference rooms to ensure the safety of all workers. Warfel's offices are currently closed to non-employees.
