



Warfel Construction is currently looking to hire a Drywall Hanger / Finisher based out of our Lancaster, PA office. The Drywall Hanger / Finisher will largely be responsible for securing drywall panels to the interior of residential and commercial construction buildings. The role will also include any additional preparation required to hang drywall in a manner that ensures a quality finished project. This role may also be responsible for additional construction-related tasks, such as providing support to Carpenters and conducting general labor tasks.

This position reports directly to the jobsite Foreman or Superintendent in addition to the Field Manager. All roles at Warfel Construction require strict adherence to all Warfel safety rules and regulations, including any site-specific necessities.

Standard work hours are M – F, beginning at 7:00 AM through 3:30 PM with a 30-minute lunch. Occasional Saturday work and overtime may be required. Travel to and from the jobsite varies; reliable transportation is required. This position does require the ability to work in ever-changing work environments, including variable weather conditions.

Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Measures and cuts drywall panels to fit in and around specific spaces such as doors, windows, electrical outlets and lighting fixtures
- Prepares panels by sawing, drilling, or cutting holes in the panels for electrical outlets, air-conditioning units, and plumbing
- Installs drywall panels to wood or metal studs
- Layers plaster or spackle with trowels to create a flat surface
- Sands joint compound once dry and applies drywall tape
- Creates textured surfaces when requested
- Conceals any imperfections or exposed irregularities in the drywall surface
- As needed, will be responsible for repairing cracks and smoothing imperfections on walls and ceilings to create surfaces suitable for final paint
- Manages and maintains all the required equipment for the job
- Ability to supply basic tools required for the position (such as tool box, hammer, nail bag, etc). A full list will be provided.
- Position may also support general laborer duties on jobsites as needed, which may include keeping work area neat and clean, loading / unloading material, provide support to Carpenters and other team members, etc.



- Performs other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma, GED, or equivalent experience
- Prior related experience as a drywall finisher required
- Ability to use and read a tape measure with precise standards and accuracy
- Basic understanding of prints, sketches, and blueprints
- Ability to measure and cut drywall to fit in specific spaces
- Must be able to use hand tools and power tools required for installing drywall
- Proven ability to work independently and as a team

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- **Standing:** Approximately 95% of your time
- **Sitting:** Approximately 5% of your time
- **Walking:** Frequent walking required as you change positions & locations
- **Lifting:** Lift & Carry materials weighing no more than 50 lbs. Frequency varies based on work at the time. Equipment is available for assistance.
- **Pushing:** Push materials weighing no more than 50 lbs. Frequency varies based on work at the time. Equipment is available for assistance.
- **Pulling:** Pull materials weighing no more than 50 lbs. Frequency varies based on work at the time. Equipment is available for assistance.
- **Climbing:** Climbing up and down ladders, scaffolds, and other objects in multi-story buildings while carrying tools & equipment may occur.
- **Bending:** Bend, kneel, crouch, and crawl as appropriate.
- **Heights:** Working at heights will vary, as well as working with various pieces of equipment that will provide protection at such heights; scaffolds, aerial man lifts, and personal fall protection.
